■ Labor Department signs lease at Sutton Place

The Kansas Department of Labor will move its offices to the fourth floor at Sutton Place, 209 E. William, its new landlord said

Wednesday.

Real Development Corp. chief executive Michael Elzufon said the company has signed a five-year lease with the state to provide 8,650

square feet of office space. The department is expected to move in the spring.

Scott Harper with Landmark Real Estate handled the lease with Real Development director of business development Craig Simon.

Sutton Place has a newly renovated lobby and is undergoing more than \$4 million in improvements. Work has started on the first floor of Sutton for the Daily Grind Coffee House and Cafe, which is expected to open by March, Elzufon said.
